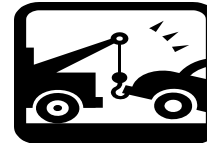

### Major Case

In August 2010, Cedar Hill Criminal Investigation Division received information of an illegal game room operating in an industrial area of Cedar Hill. Detectives conducted surveillance and initiated an undercover operation.

On 09/23/2010, detectives executed a search warrant at the location suspected of running an illegal gambling establishment in Cedar Hill. During the execution of the warrant, detectives seized 30 gaming machines known as "multi-liners", an undisclosed amount of cash, and other evi-

dence that supported the gaming operation. During the raid, detectives cited fourteen patrons for Gambling. The ownership of the establishment is currently under investigation for "Keeping a Gambling Place" and "Money Laundering".

During the initial raid, the Cedar Hill Fire Marshal, Code Enforcement, and Building Inspections conducted a walk through inspection for various violations. A follow up meeting with the landlord resulted in 5 citations by the Fire Marshall and 3 citations by the Building Inspector.
